

Gallaghers Steakhouse turns back time for charity

Meat mecca Gallagher's Steakhouse rolled back prices to its original 1927 menu on Tuesday, and donated the difference to NYU Langone Medical Center.

A porterhouse regularly \$49 could be had for just \$3.92, while the filet mignon, regularly \$45, was \$3.65. French fries went for 40 cents.

They usually cost \$9. Supporters who dined on the cheap included Ken Langone and wife Elaine, former CIA director George Tenet, Alice Tisch and Dr. Robert Grossman. The evening raised more than \$40,000.
